Austria

University of Art and Design Linz

"The University of Art and Design Linz (Kunstuniversität Linz) has its institutional and programmatic roots in the "Kunstschule" (Art School) of the City of Linz, which was founded in 1947, assigned academy status in 1973 and finally made a fully-fledged university in 1998. The institution was conceived as an explicit statement to signify dissociation from the previous art policy of the National Socialist era. This is in particular exemplified by its emphasis on the fundamental values of freedom of art and research, its commitment to modernism and contemporary art and the positioning of the University at the interface of free-artistic and applied-economically oriented design. In the past as in the present, these values form the basis of the fundamental essence and identity of Kunstuniversität Linz."

Exchange students from Borås will enrol in courses part of the department *Fashion* \mathcal{E} *Technology*. The courses are part of either the 2^{nd} or 6^{th} semester of the Linz BA programme.

Although German language knowledge is not required, students are recommended to have some basic knowledge before their exchange

France

École Nationale Supérieure des Arts Décoratifs (in French only)

"The École des Arts Décoratifs, which has been a wellspring of intellectual, creative and artistic blossoming for over 250 years, aims to give the future generations of artists and designers the tools they need to shape and create the visual scenery of tomorrow's world.

Every year, over 800 creators working in one of 10 departments (Art-Space, Interior Architecture, Animation, Graphic Design, Product Design, Textile and Texture Design, Fashion Design, Printed Image, Photography/Video, Stage Design) strive to create the tangible, visual and imaginary environment of our world and to reflect on the transformations of the societal and artistic landscape.

Its unique teaching method, outward looking attitude and remarkable research department place the École des Arts Décoratifs among the few leading art, design and fashion schools."⁴

IMPORTANT NOTE! Students must be fluent in French, as the language of instruction is French. No courses are offered in English.

Germany

Weissensee School of Art and Design Berlin

"The weissensee school of art and design berlin was founded in 1946 as an alternative to the traditional art academy. Building on the ideas and teaching of the Bauhaus movement, the school of art and design stands out because of its unique profile. It offers more than 800 students from Germany and abroad a one-year, interdisciplinary course of foundation studies. These basics in art and design are followed by diploma studies in free art as well as bachelor and master's degrees in design." ⁵

Exchange students will enrol in courses alongside undergraduate students from Fashion Design. The primary language of instruction at Weissensee is German, but the teaching staff have international experience, and tuition is held in English if necessary.

Lithuania

Vilnius Academy of Arts

"Vilnius Academy of Arts (VDA) is a State University of the Republic of Lithuania, that offers study programmes in all three study cycles in the areas of art, design, architecture, and art theory and history. The Academy consists of four campuses, situated in the cities of Vilnius, Kaunas, Klaipėda and Telšiai, with a total of over 1800 students."

Exchange students from Borås will select courses in the Fashion Design BA at the Faculty of Vilnius.

Although the main language of instruction is Lithuanian, it is clarified that fashion design courses involve a lot of individual tutoring and are mostly taught in mixed groups, where exchange students receive their assignments and feedback in English. Courses taught entirely in Lithuanian are not listed in the course catalogue. Students can also add elective courses to create an individual study plan based on their own preferences.

Spain

ELISAVA Barcelona School of Design and Engineering

"Elisava, Barcelona School of Design and Engineering of the Universitat de Vic – Universitat Central de Catalunya (UVic-UCC), fourth best Catalan university and sixth in Spain, promotes education, knowledge and research in the fields of design, industrial design engineering and communication."

Exchange students will integrate with ELISAVA students in elective subjects that are part of the Bachelor in Design and Innovation. Courses will be specialised in either Graphic Design, Product Design, Interior Design, or Interactive Experiences Design.

The primary language of instruction ELISVA is Spanish, but the teaching staff have international experience, and tuition is held in English if necessary. Incoming exchange students are recommended to have some basic knowledge before their exchange.

One academic semester of full-time studies corresponds to 30 ECTS.

Australia/Vietnam

Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology

"RMIT has three campuses and two sites in Australia, two campuses in Vietnam and a research and industry collaboration in Spain. Melbourne City Campus is located in the cosmopolitan heart of the "world's most liveable city" and is surrounded by public transport, restaurants, cafes, theatres, galleries and parks. Our City Campus has 45,000 students studying in across all major interest areas. The campus has been an integral part of Melbourne's character for more than one hundred years.

RMIT Vietnam was established in 2000 and has grown into a leading university in the region, with two well-equipped campuses in Ho Chi Minh City and Hanoi. The programs and courses we offer are identical to those offered at RMIT University, Melbourne. We have over 7,000 students enrolled at our two Vietnam campuses, with numbers steadily increasing." ¹⁰

Students from Borås interested to do an exchange semester at RMIT may choose to study at RMIT, either in Australia or Vietnam. One academic semester of full-time studies corresponds to 48 credits at RMIT where each course represents 12 credits.

RMIT Vietnam requires students to purchase insurance costing 5,700,000 Đồng. Students should be aware that the visa fee to study in Australia increased to A\$1,600 as of 1 July 2024.
